The Australian National Championships provides competition for young and old, with competitors from 9 years and under to Veteran divisions.

This will be the third year that Wakeboard Australia has teamed up with sponsorship partners, Mobius Boats, Ocean and Earth and RedBull, as part of a 5 year sponsorship commitment making it the **largest wakeboarding contest in the country**.

All competitors will be treated to ride the best wakes in the industry, both the Supra 24SSV and 22SSV wakeboard boats.
